

### **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**

I've loved this show since I first saw the National Touring production in 2013, and it's been such a pleasure watching our cast, crew, and designers come to love it as well. *Peter and the Starcatcher* offers a fresh and lively take on one of the most classic children's stories of all time. In an age where film and television have largely taken over the work of telling stories as realistically as possible, this play embraces fantasy from the very first minute: when the characters explicitly ask the audience to "Imagine." Our goal with this production in both technical design and performance is to embrace that sense of make-believe, and the quality of imagination that lets you turn what you are given into more than it was before.

This play is technically a prequel to *Peter Pan*, providing an origin story for the magical cast of characters that populate J.M. Barrie's classic story. How did a ragtag group of boys – and an equally ragtag group of pirates – end up on a mermaid-infested island anyway? What exactly does Peter Pan have against growing up? Is there any responsible way to portray the native-Neverlanders of the original story in 2022? This play's explanations are somehow simultaneously sadder and sillier than those in the source material, and the result is a wild adventure that mixes very real fears with plenty of laughs.

This production isn't about convincing the audience that anything is actually what it is; it's about the joy of pretending. While working on it, we've had an immense amount of joy, creativity, and laughter: all wonderful qualities to bring to both life and theatre. We hope you'll enjoy your own trip to Neverland, and your journey to the wonderful possibilities of the imagination available to the young, and to the young at heart.
